MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents

What a start to 2021!

Firstly, I want to express my huge thanks to all parents for helping our children with the transition from learning in school to remote learning so well. We know it can be incredibly hard for you to juggle work commitments and provide support for children in their learning on a daily basis; you have been doing an incredible job. As you know we are providing remote learning through Zoom. Due to the increased time children will have at home, we have reviewed what we will be offering online and new timetables will start from Monday 25th January. This is for two reasons.

- 1. An eye health charity is recommending people learn the "20-20-20" rule to protect their sight, as lockdown has increased people's time using screens. Fight for Sight advises looking at something 20 feet away for 20 seconds, every 20 minutes you look at a screen. We have built regular breaks into the timetables to address this issue.
- 2. In order to accommodate teaching in school alongside Zoom lessons, we have had to make some changes to lunchtimes to ensure that pupils in school and at home get enough time to have their lunch.

As you know, we are open to teach critical worker and priority children as well as providing online learning for children at home and this has been a bia task but we are making improvements every day with this. It is a worrying time for all of us and I know that by minimising children on site, we can keep our staff and your children at a reduced risk of infection, as well as reduce the chance of Coronavirus being transmitted to others in vour home.
