
Miss Minter





What Finch Class have been up to this week.


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This half term we have been looking at writing our narratives and making our punctuation really accurate. We need to remember to include !, ?, noun phrases, apostrophes for contaction and possession, in our writing.





We have used VIPERS for our reading skills. Ask your child what VIPERS means.

We have starting multiplication using multiple groups and arrays. We have to know our 2,5 and 10 times table for year 2.



Read to Succeed

Once a week the class teacher will check the diary to see how many times it has been signed by a parents (or child in upper Key Stage 2). When they have read 35 times, the children will earn their first reward. They can then start working towards their next reward.

- Read 35 times at home Bronze certificate
- Read 70 times at home Silver certificate
- Read 100 times at home Gold certificate
- Read 150 times at home "Read to succeed" medal
- Read 200 times at home Read to Succeed Party (teddy bear picnic for KS1) at the end of the summer term!
