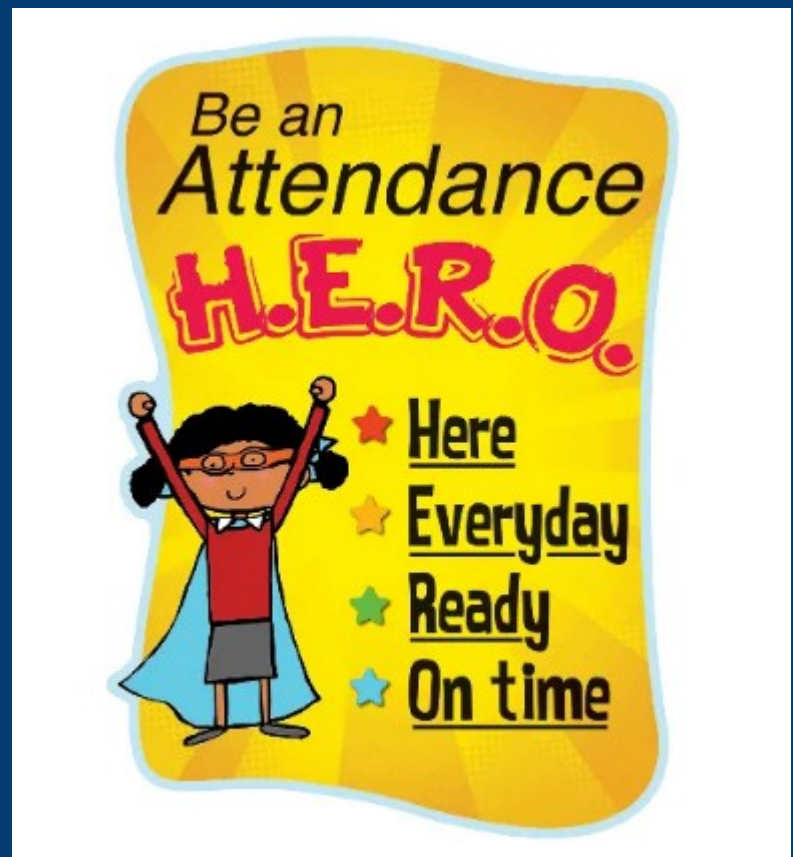

Multi Cultural Week

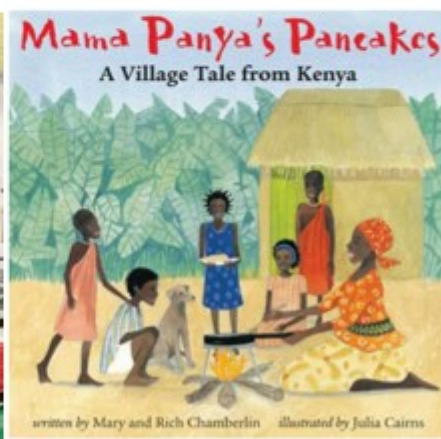
We have spent time learning about different cultures and languages this week. We've danced, sung and painted !
