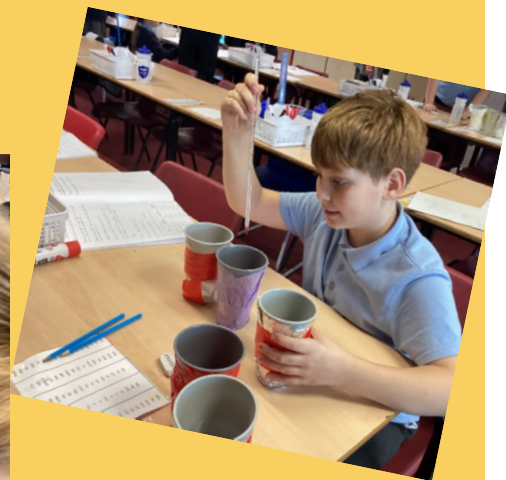
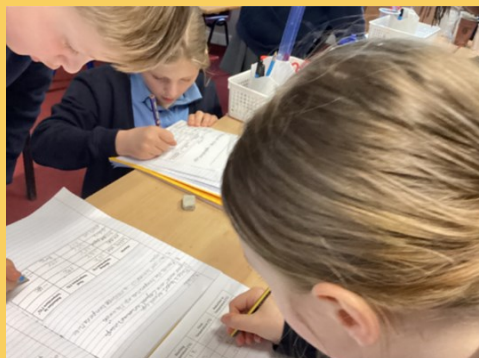
British Science Week

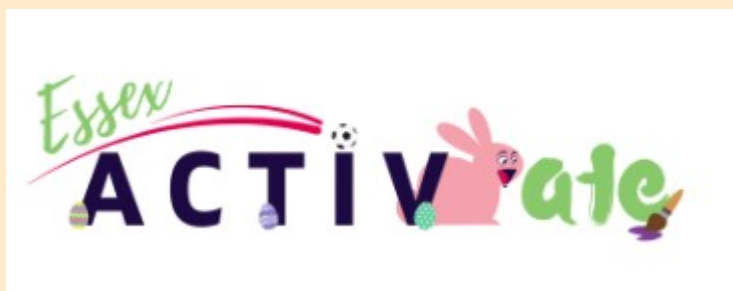
Holiday Activity and Food Funding

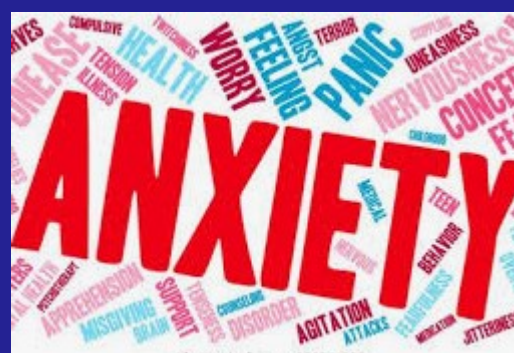
