

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Free School Meals - Important Information

On 1 April 2018, Transitional Protection (TP) Free School Meals (FSM) was introduced. This meant that if a pupil's eligibility to means tested FSM ended, they would remain entitled to FSM, which would last until the end of the phase of education that they are in when TP ends.

Transitional protection for Free School Meals is ending on 31 March 2025.

From 1 April 2025, the Government's transitional protection arrangements for means tested Free School Meals (FSM) will end. Any eligible claims confirmed from this date will no longer be protected. This means any child confirmed as eligible for free school meals from 1 April 2025 will be subject to ongoing checks to confirm continued eligibility. This will not impact any children who are already confirmed as eligible.

For all pupils who become eligible for FSM for the first time from 01 April 2025; their FSM eligibility will be reviewed regularly and status changed accordingly and paid meals added to their MYCAS account for payment.

Children in reception, year 1 and year 2 automatically get free school meals. This is called <u>Universal infant free school meals (UIFSM)</u> and you do not need to apply for it.

If you are a low income family and your child will be using free school meals, you can support your school by letting them know you are using the service. Your school will then be eligible to apply for more funding to support the provision of education for children in the school.

Read the list of bullet points under 'Children in year 3' to determine whether you are a low income family.

If your child is in Year 3 or above, and you receive one of the listed qualifying benefits, your child may be eligible for free school meals.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (not Working Tax Credit), with an annual income below £16,190
- Pension Guarantee Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance, income related
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act, 1999
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Universal Credit, with a household income of £7,400 or less (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

- **Stop!** Stand on the pavement near the kerb.
- Look and listen! Look all around for traffic and listen.
- Wait! Until it's safe to cross. If traffic is coming, let it pass.
- Look and listen again! ...
- Arrive Safely
