All children return on Wednesday 2nd September 2026. Reception children will complete a half day on Wednesday 2nd September being collected 1.30pm from the school office.

Start and finishing times:

School gates and classroom doors will be open from 8.25am. Registration is at 8.35am.

- School finishes at 3.15pm Monday – Thursday and 1pm on Friday.

Gate allocations:

- All children to enter the school playground for the start of the day via the gate next to the house. Entry to KS1 will be through the playground.
- Children entering the KS2 newer block, will all be entering and leaving via the cloakroom door.
- Senior Leaders will be outside on Wednesday 2nd September to direct families to their correct classrooms.
- Children to be collected from their classroom at 3.15pm Monday-Thursday and 1pm on Friday.

Breakfast club:

Breakfast club starts at 8am, there is no charge. Please contact the school office for more information.

Snacks & Lunches:

- Children can bring in a healthy snack from home for break time. All KS1 children are provided with fruit for break time.
- Please be reminded we are a nut free school, this includes spread within sandwiches.

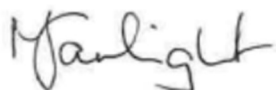
